## **Houston Continues to Make Substantial Reductions in Homelessness**

The Coalition for the Homeless recently released the results of its annual Point-in-Time Homeless Count for 2016. This year's results show that **Houston has reduced overall homelessness by an incredible 57% since 2011**. Homelessness in the Greater Houston area decreased by 21% just since last year, continuing a five-year downward trend in reducing homelessness. According to the count, there are approximately 3,600 individuals experiencing homelessness in our community on a given night, down from 4,600 last year and 8,500 in 2011. Of those that were homeless, 1,050 were identified as being unsheltered, showing a 73 percent reduction in unsheltered homelessness from 2011.

This incredible progress is due to the efforts of The Way Home, Houston's community-wide action plan to end homelessness. SEARCH is a leader and key implementer of The Way Home, fulfilling numerous critical roles in the city's system to address homelessness.
